Theme: This term we are focusing our learning around the story *We're Going on a Bear Hunt* by Michael Rosen, this will open up a world of fun learning opportunities, particularly about story sequencing, sensory play and Bears! Your children are welcome to share any relevant items with us (including books, photos, or games).

We are also focussing on **Sustainable Development Goal 15: Life on Land,** particularly the question "Why do we need trees? building children's knowledge and understanding through age-appropriate activities. EYPP funding: To support learning at home and the development of Communication and Language and Literacy for all of the children, we have used some of the Early Years Pupil Premium funding to purchase a book for each child, either about transition to school, or around the current theme. We have purchased the majority of books from "WOB", a fabulous online second-hand book shop, which follows our ethos of sustainability and our commitment to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. We are currently enjoying sharing the stories with all of the children, and we will be sending a copy home for each child to keep and share with their family, along with ideas for learning at home, towards the end of term. We hope you will enjoy sharing these books with your children.

Help with fees: We strongly recommend that all parents visit *www.childcarechoices.gov.uk* you may be surprised by the help that is available, including tax-free childcare which is available alongside your funded hours to cover additional fees. If you think you may be eligible for extended hours (up to 30 hours) please visit *www.childcarechoices.gov.uk* and follow the steps to get a code. It is imperative that you give us your code before 14th July, if you wish to claim extended hours in September, and then keep us informed of your ongoing eligibility.

Sun Protection: Thank you for ensuring your child's delicate skin is protected by applying sunscreen before they come into pre-school. We re-apply after lunchtime for the children who attend all day. Please ensure that sunhats are named, to help avoid confusion.

If your child is returning to us in September, please collect your child's Learning Journal on their last session before the summer holiday, so that you can continue adding to their Learning Journal during the break. Please return it to us when your child returns to pre-school in September.

Friday 7th July: We will be holding an end of year Family Summer Disco, at Hersden Club 19.00 – 22.00. Everyone welcome – friends and family, look out for fliers and posters!!

Tuesday 18th July: Please remember that pre-school is CLOSED for an inset day.
